

How to Add a LinkedIn Learning Assignment into a Canvas Course

Notes:

- For the best experience, it's recommended that you use Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome when working with LinkedIn Learning in Canvas.
- LinkedIn Learning Assignments are not compatible with the Student View.
- Students will have access to any included Exercise Files in the LinkedIn Learning Content added to your course.

Step 1

Navigate to the Assignments tab in your course.

Step 2

Click on the + Assignment button to begin creating the assignment (you can also create an assignment directly in a module).



Steps 3, 4, and 5

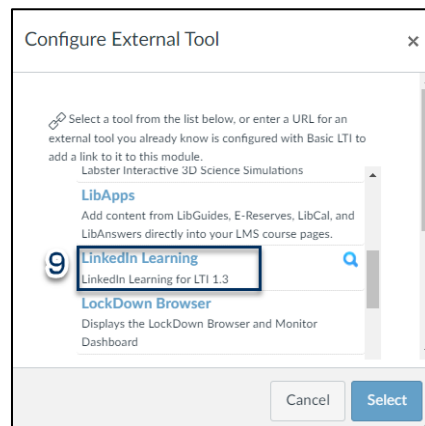
The Assignment Name (3), Assignment Description (4), and Points (5) will be added automatically by LinkedIn Learning. You can edit these later once the Assignment has been created.

Step 6

Set the **Display Grade as** field to **points** or if ungraded, **complete/incomplete**.

Step 9

In the **Configure External Tool** pop-up box, scroll down the list of available external tools and click on **LinkedIn Learning**.



Step 10

In the **Link Resource from External Tool** pop-up box that opens, you will be able to use the **Search for content** bar to search and find the content you wish to bring into Canvas.

Step 11

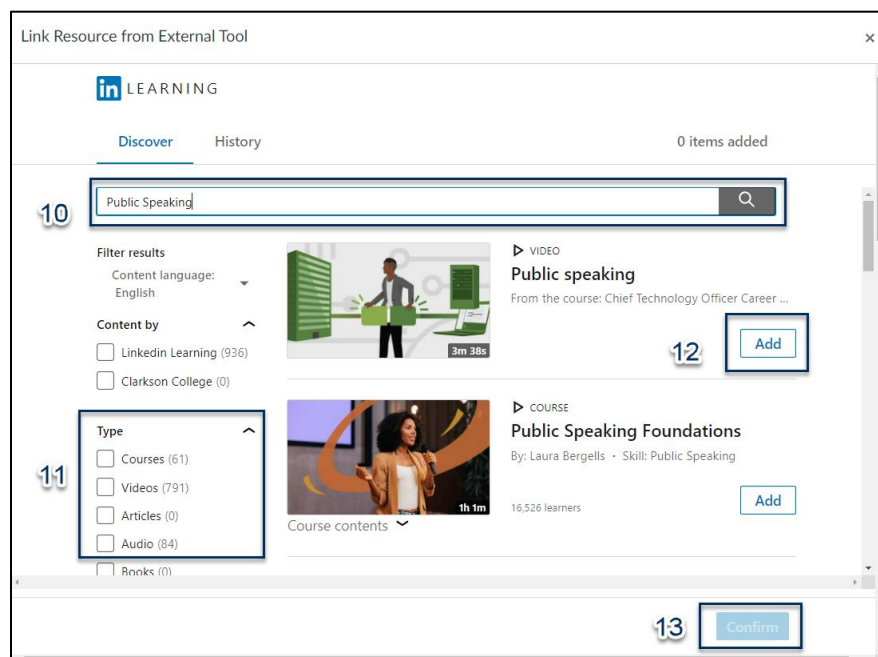
You can **Refine** the Search Results with **Filtering by Type** to aid in locating the desired content.

Step 12

Select **Add** next to one of the items within the list of available materials.

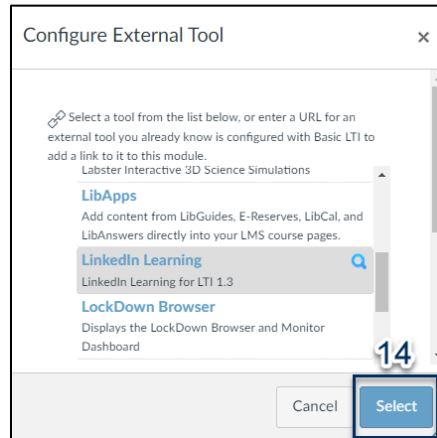
Step 13

Click the **Confirm** button.



Step 14

In the **Configure External Tool** pop-up box, click the **Select** button.



Step 15

You can now adjust the Assignment Name, Description, and Points.
